

Rules and Regulations for Bay City Western Aesthikos Chapter of National Honor Society

1. Attendance
  - a. Attendance to monthly meetings is mandatory
  - b. Any absences must be due to Extenuating Circumstances as outlined in the attendance policy.
  - c. Consequences for absence
    - i. 1 absence: warning
    - ii. 2 absences will meet with faculty committee and this may be grounds for dismissal from organization
2. Requirements
  - a. Participation in these annual events is mandatory: such as bake sales, Daffodil Days, school food drives (or other agreed upon school event)
  - b. Volunteer 30 hours
    - i. NHS required projects
    - ii. Need to have a minimum of three different projects
    - iii. No more than 20 hours for a given project
    - iv. Follow the school guidelines for volunteer projects
    - v. Hours need to be completed by designated deadline to maintain membership status (If hours are not turned in, member needs to meet with faculty committee.)
3. Selection Process
  - a. Any junior or senior with a G.P.A. of 3.2 and above is eligible
  - b. Students will be informed by letter and PA announcement to pick up application form and return by designated date and time.
  - c. Staff will evaluate students on service, character, and leadership
  - d. Staff scores are averaged together + GPA/2= Total score (must be 3.50 or above to qualify)
  - e. Faculty committee will review scores and comments to determine final selection
4. Grounds for Dismissal
  - a. Any violation of school or athletic code of conduct
  - b. Any documented legal misconduct is grounds for dismissal.
  - c. To appeal a dismissal, a student must schedule a meeting with the faculty committee within one week of notification. A final ruling will be determined by the faculty committee.
